I am asking for your help in making this a successful year for a worthy applicant. Together, let us inform and encourage the guidance counselors in our schools to promote the St. Michael's Scholarship to qualified students in our parish community, who are making St. Michael's College at the University of Toronto their 1st choice for their post secondary education. The University of St. Michael's College (USMC), established in 1852 and federated with the University of Toronto since 1910, is a Catholic institution of higher learning founded by the Congregation of St. Basil.
