## “Living Justice: A CWL Response”

Led by Luke Stocking, Deputy Director of Public Awareness and Engagement (Ontario and Atlantic Region), members discerned and developed themes based on three of the Catholic Social Teaching principles:

1. Human Dignity
2. Solidarity
3. The Dignity of Work and Rights of Workers

Luke explained the long association that Development and Peace has with the CWL and informed us some of the projects currently in place in various countries made possible by the CWL 1% contribution program.

Toronto Diocesan Council committee chairs explained how these principles can impact the work done through these committees. During breakout sessions, councils spent time collaborating, brainstorming and reflecting on possible ways to promote the principles at the parish level. This event was held virtually and 262 members participated and also received a workbook based on the three principles.
