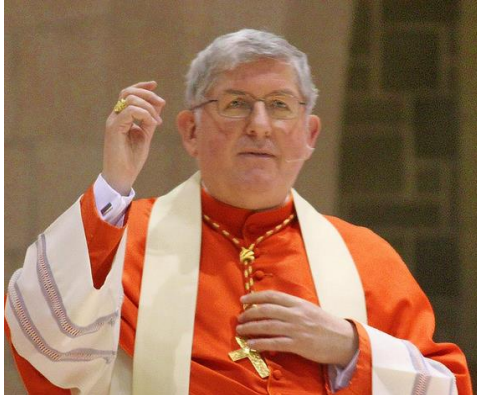


## **Best wishes to Cardinal Thomas Collins and congratulations to Archbishop-designate Frank Leo**
