Mary in her term as Past President, 2013-2015 consulted with Moira's family on their wishes and the executive of the day on its feasibility and structure. Among other input from the executive, Fr. Robert O'Brien, Spiritual Advisor suggestedhostingthe LectureSeries every second year.

The Lecture Series was named in honor of Moira because she had contributed greatly to the League in her service at the Parish, Region, Diocesan, Provincial and National levels.
