- Attendance and participation at League and other events.
- Maximum 2-3 pages using the attached template.
- Maintain page margins of 2.54 cm (1") for top/bottom and left/right side.

Background COVID-19 Pandemic Emergency

- March 11. 2020: The World Health Organization (WHO) declared the novel coronavirus or COVID-19 (SARS 2) outbreak a global pandemic.
- March 17, 2020, the Ontario Government also declared a state of emergency.
- April 4, 2023, Ontario declared the COVID-19 pandemic over as the province moved to the endemic stage of the virus.
- May 5, 2023, the WHO ended the COVID-19 pandemic global health emergency.
- Our vocabulary included words such as pivoting, quarantine, lockdown, social isolating and physical distancing, community spread, flattening the curve, virtuals, Zoom, PPEs, masking, vaccines, variants and more.
